## Who is this program for?

If you have any concerns  
regarding your child's mental  
or behavioral health, this  
program is for you.

- Any child or young adult up to 21 years old years who in Montana
- Your child does not need to have had any form of mental health support in the past

## What kind of support does this program provide?

Our goal is to provide accessible  
& compassionate care that  
empowers your child & your  
family to thrive. The kinds of care  
we provide include:

- Short-term interventions (1-8 weeks),
- Longer-term therapy
- Medication management
- Other forms of supportive interventions tailored to your child's need.

## How much does it cost?

If you have health insurance,  
the cost of care will vary  
depending on your individual  
policy. We work with private  
insurance and Montana  
Medicaid. If you do not have  
insurance, or don't wish to use  
it, a cash pay option is also  
available.
